Please share your proposals for papers, in Spanish or English, that report original results, completed or in progress, on any of the following topics of academic integrity:

- Educational innovation: resources, experiences and good practices in favor of Academic Integrity.
- Regulations to strengthen Academic Integrity (standards and management).
- Culture of Academic Integrity.
- Integrity and the digital world.
- Artificial intelligence and its implications in Academic Integrity.
- From Academic Integrity to professional ethics.

The aspects to be taken into account by the evaluation committee, integrated by the collaborating universities, are:

- 1. Thematic relevance: correspondence with the topics mentioned and of special interest at present.
- 2. Methodological rigor: Clear, orderly and well-articulated exposition of the proposal's approaches that lead to the conclusions, making good use of data, experiences or theoretical foundations.
- 3. Value of the results: Clear and valuable results, relevant to the field of academic integrity.
- 4. Applicability of conclusions: Conclusions or findings of interest to other universities, that can be applied or replicated.

Formats:

Presentation: 25 minutes.

Poster: 10 minutes. Workshop: 25 minutes.

Deadline to receive proposals: July 31

Deadline for results: August 19

















The 12th Conference on Academic Integrity will be held on site and online on September 25, 26 and 27, 2024, and it is a great opportunity to share resources, tools and best practices to strengthen the culture of academic integrity among students, teachers and educational leaders at national and international educational institutions.
